We wanted to communicate some of the latest information regarding this NRHA competition season. Please feel free to distribute to your affiliate:

The qualification for the 2021 Adequan® North American Affiliate Championships (NAAC) is as follows: Each competitor is required to have an affiliate membership and a score higher than zero at their Affiliate Regional Championship in each class they are looking to qualify in. In addition, if a competitor wins an ARC class on a specific horse, they cannot enter that class on the same horse at another ARC. For the full details please visit:

As we are not requiring rosters or designations this year, please feel free to track your members however you would like for 2021 without the worry of sending them to NRHA. We will require a space on all ARC entry forms for competitors to record which affiliate they are a member of, as well as for show managers to provide membership forms at the ARC for them to join an affiliate if they are not currently a member of one. Due to this process, there is no need to submit affiliate rosters for 2021 to NRHA.

The Affiliate Committee will be reviewing the qualification process for the 2022 NAAC, and ReinerSuite will have the ability to support that process either internally and/or externally.
